Daily Themes:

Besides our weekly mystery themes, each day at Mystery Academy Super Sleuths specializes in one particular area.

- **Mondays:**
 - **Who did it?**
 - Mondays will be dedicated to uncovering interesting people. Who invented the science of astronomy? Who developed the computer? Super sleuths will have the chance to read and write biographies, along with finding out more about themselves.
- **Tuesdays:**
 - **What is it?**
 - Tuesdays will be dedicated to uncovering knowledge of different items. What is Morse code? What is an incantation? Super sleuths will build specific vocabulary related to the weekly themes and discover what things are. Super sleuths will also uncover what formulas are and be able to use them for additional fun!
- **Wednesdays:**
 - **When is it?**
 - Wednesdays will be dedicated to studying when certain things occurred. Time lines will be explained and then created. History sleuths will enjoy finding out about different eras, past, present and future.
- **Thursdays:**
 - **Where is it?**
 - Thursdays will be dedicated to finding out locations. Geography sleuths will enjoy map reading and making maps to hidden treasures.
- **Fridays:**
 - **Why is it?**
 - Fridays will be dedicated to unlocking the mystery of why things work the way they do. Science sleuths will enjoy dismantling and reassembling items to discover why they work the way they do.
